HISTORY

Zanzibar is an archipelago made up of the two main islands of Unguja (also known as Zanzibar Island) and Pemba, as well as roughly 51 smaller islets. In the United Republic of Tanzania, Zanzibar is a partner state with the mainland.

The name Zanzibar is derived from the Arabic terms 'Zenj', which means black, and 'bar,' which means land, giving in the historic term 'Land of the Black.' Zanzibar absorbed people from all over the world, including the Orient, Iberia, Assyria, and India. Pemba is the Archipelago's second biggest island, known to Arab mariners as Al-khudra, or "The Green Island". It is famous for its clove production and its channels offer some of the best diving experiences in East Africa.



GETTING THERE

The principal carrier to Zanzibar is Kenya Airways transit at Nairobi, Ethiopian Airlines transit at Addis Ababa, Oman Air transit to Muscat, onetime Airline direct from Turkish Airways, Eurowings discovery, Lufthansa-Edelweiss Airline, KLM, Qatar and Air France. Other carriers such as Swiss and British Airways stopping over Dar es Salaam, from where you can catch ferry to Zanzibar. There are also a number of regular charter flights from Europe travelling direct to Zanzibar. If your ticket takes you only to Dar es Salaam, local air carrier such as ZanAir, Coastal, Tropical Air, Precision Air provide scheduled flights in small twin-engines to Zanzibar.



VISA PROCEDURES & CUSTOMS

The visitors require a valid passport and visa for the duration of their stay. Visa can have obtained from Tanzania Diplomatic Mission or alternatively at the entry points. The rate of visa currently \$50. However, it is advisable to check with your nearest Tanzanian Embassy. High Commission or Consulate prior to your travel for updated information.



POPULATION

Zanzibar consists of a multiracial and multicultural community. It is a society of many faiths and of different origins. Almost the entire population is of

mixed races primarily of Arab and African decent and blended with local culture. The current population of Zanzibar according to 2012 census is 1,303,569 inhabitants with an annual growth rate of 4.55%.

ZANZIBAR GOVERNMENT

Zanzibar is a part of Tanzania's United Republic, with its own government and president. It has a popularly elected House of Representatives and cabinet ministers for all subjects that are not related to the Union. Zanzibar has been a multiparty democracy since the 1995 election.

HOSPITALITY & CULTURE

Zanzibar cultures become more diverse in its range, more unique in its expression. Zanzibar is the birthplace of Swahili, a lingua franca forged from global dialects, upon which legends were carried, trade routes opened and a Sultan's empire prospered. It is here that the African culture blended with other cultures mainly Persian, Arabic and Indian to form Swahili culture. Today the romance, vibrantly alive, traditional sailing dhows, carved wooden doors, chests, scent of cloves and the smile of the hospitable people welcome you to Zanzibar.

CLIMATE

The Zanzibar archipelago is a tropical island and its climate is subject to the whims of monsoon winds. The northern monsoon (known as Kaskazi in Swahili) lasts three to four months from April to November. The rainy seasons (Maskika) starts in March or April and lasts in May. June to October is the dry and the temperatures are clement. There are short rains known as vuli. Zanzibar gets about



60 inches of rains annually. The maximum temperatures are 88.50F in February and 810F in July. The minimum temperatures are 800F in march and 710F in June.



GEOGRAPHY

The two islands lie 35 kilometers off the coast of mainland Tanzania in the Indian Ocean, at longitude 39 degrees east and latitude 6 degrees south of the Equator. Pemba stretches for 40 kilometres and is 14 miles broad. It covers 608 square miles of land (2,332 square kilometers). It's around 36 miles away from the continent and 29 miles north of Unguja Island. Unguja stretches for 50 kilometers and is 24 miles broad. It has a 995-square-mile surface area. At its narrowest point, it is separated from the continent by a 21-mile corridor. It rises 390 feet above sea level at its greatest point.



HEALTH & SAFETY

Visitors to Zanzibar are no longer required by law to have Yellow Fever vaccination certificate. When you enter the country, please see your local doctor or Travel Clinic for further information about inoculations required for the area.

Malaria is still prevalent in East Africa and so one should also take a malaria prophylaxis. There are many different kinds of medications for Malaria. However, precautions should be taken to avoid being bitten by mosquitos. Apply insect repellent and sleep under mosquito nets at night. Wear long-sleeved shirts and trousers in the evenings.

Zanzibar is not much infected by HIV/AIDS. However, you are advised to avoid all AIDS fueling factors.

As in almost all African countries, it is pleased to drink bottled water and avoid uncooked foods that may be have been washed untreated water. Sunstroke and heat exhaustion are common, so drink sufficient water, wear sensible clothing and use a high-factor sunscreen.

Zanzibar is a safe country and most locals are friendly and honest. Though simple precautions should be taken so as to have a relaxing and interesting stay in one of the most beautiful places on earth.

Media and communication provides access for tourists and investors to the latest technologies in sound, printing, and visual communication companies that keep your home away from home. RELIGION

The majority of Zanzibar residents practice the Islamic faith which reflect also their life style and culture. Mosques are sacred places and usually no entry by non-Muslims. During the holy month of Ramadan Muslims are fasting from dawn to sunset and you may find difficult to find food during the day. However, same specified restaurants are allowed to serve the tourists. There are also Christian churches and Hindu temples which offer regular services on Sunday and on special occasions.



SHOPPING

As you stroll through Stone Town, you will find several shops selling wood carvings, Zanzibari chests, clothes, spices, jewellery, paintings and antiques. Most of the gift shops are situated along Kenyatta Road in Shangani, and Gizenga Street behind the Old Fort. Tourists are advised not to buy any products related to protected species on the islands, such as sea shells and turtles. A holiday to Zanzibar would be incomplete without visiting these souvenir shops.

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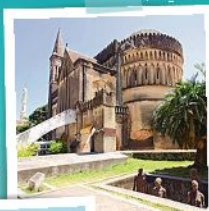

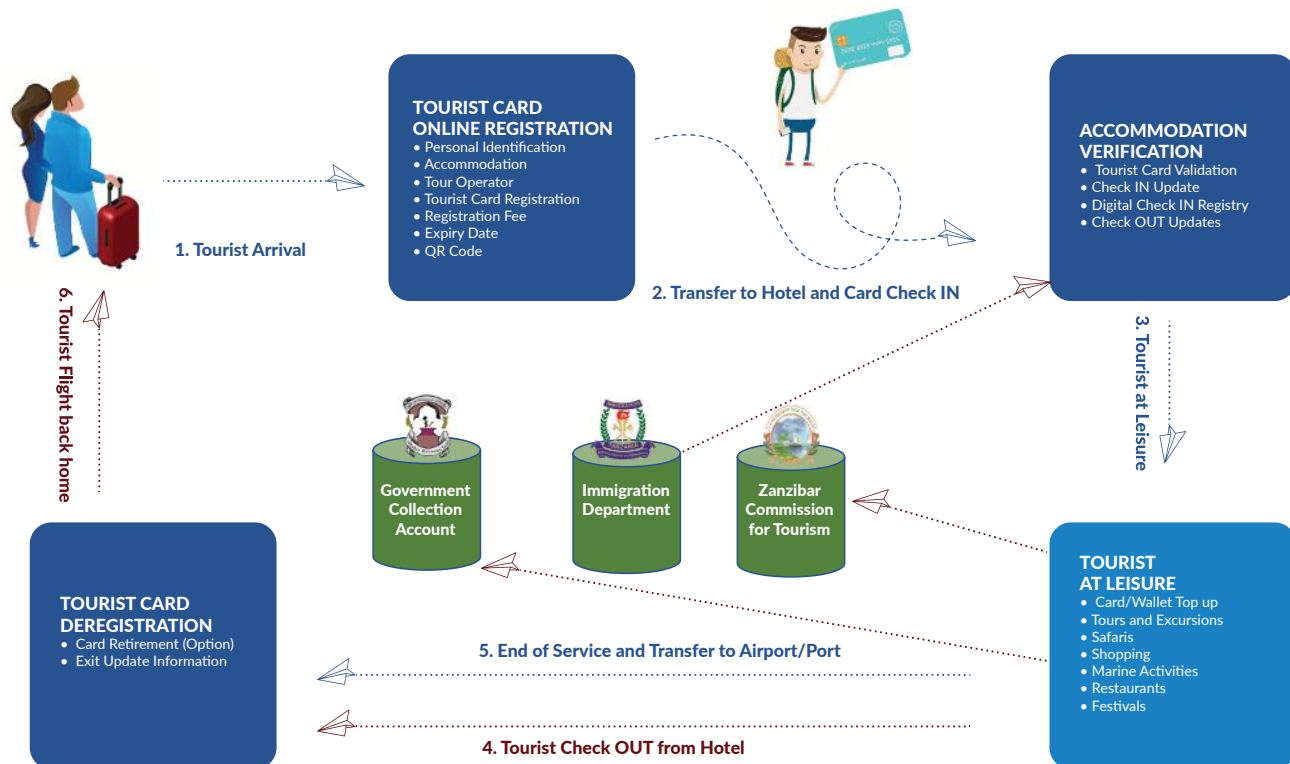
2. Zanzibar Tourism Card

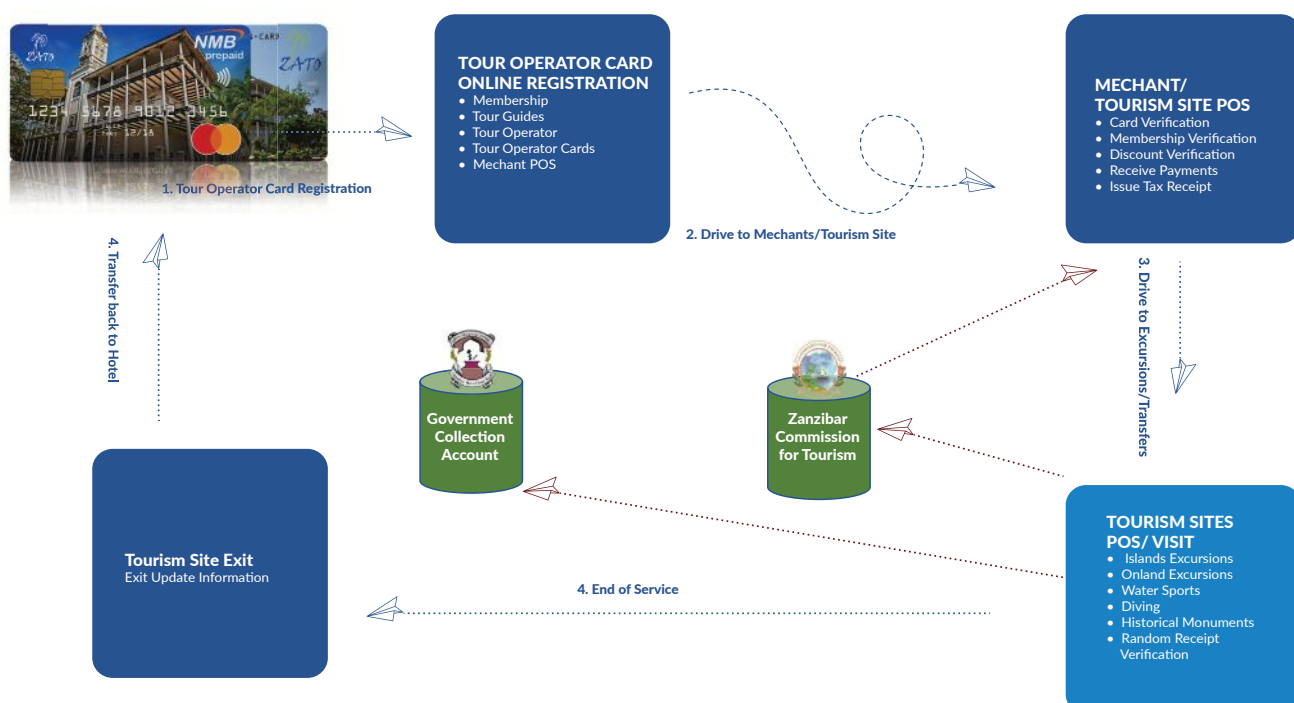
This system will have the following benefits:-

Zanzibar festivals rekindle interest in local culture among young people, create chances for artists and musicians, and bring people together to engage and learn from one another. Our festivals range in style, content, and atmosphere, offering something for everyone while preserving traditions and promoting Zanzibar as an example for responsible tourism that respects local culture.

Festivals and fairs abound in Zanzibar. Each festival celebrates a distinct occasion, such as the new year (Mwaka Kogwa), the film festival, the music festivals, and religious holidays such as Eid and Maulid day. Zanzibar festivals allow people to bond with their roots, culture, and customs while also helping to protect the environment.

For a large number of people from many cultures, nothing beats festivals, whether they are major cultural celebrations, traditional festivals, music and dance, arts and crafts, food, traditional sports, exotic and authentic events such as Mwaka kogwa and dhow races, film festivals, and, of course, Sauti za Busara, also recognized as one of the world's friendliest festivals. They feature different performers from East Africa and other regions of the African continent, both acoustic and electric, as well as some of the biggest names in African music, all performing 100% live.

Nyerere National Park

Formally known as Selous Game Reserve

A newly established Park which is part of what is known as Selous Game Reserve. Founded in 2019 and covers an area of over 30,000 square kilometers, now the largest National Park in Africa.

The park boasts Tanzania's largest population of elephant as well as a large number of lions, leopards, African hunting dogs, buffaloes and hippos. Species commonly seen are bushbucks, red and blue duikers, elands, hartebeests, hyenas, giraffes, Oryx, reedbucks, impalas, waterbucks and zebras.

The park has the most extensive diversity of safari activities ranging from Romantic Boat Safari along the Great Rufiji River, legendary fly camping trips, walking and compliment standard game driving in thriving wildlife areas.

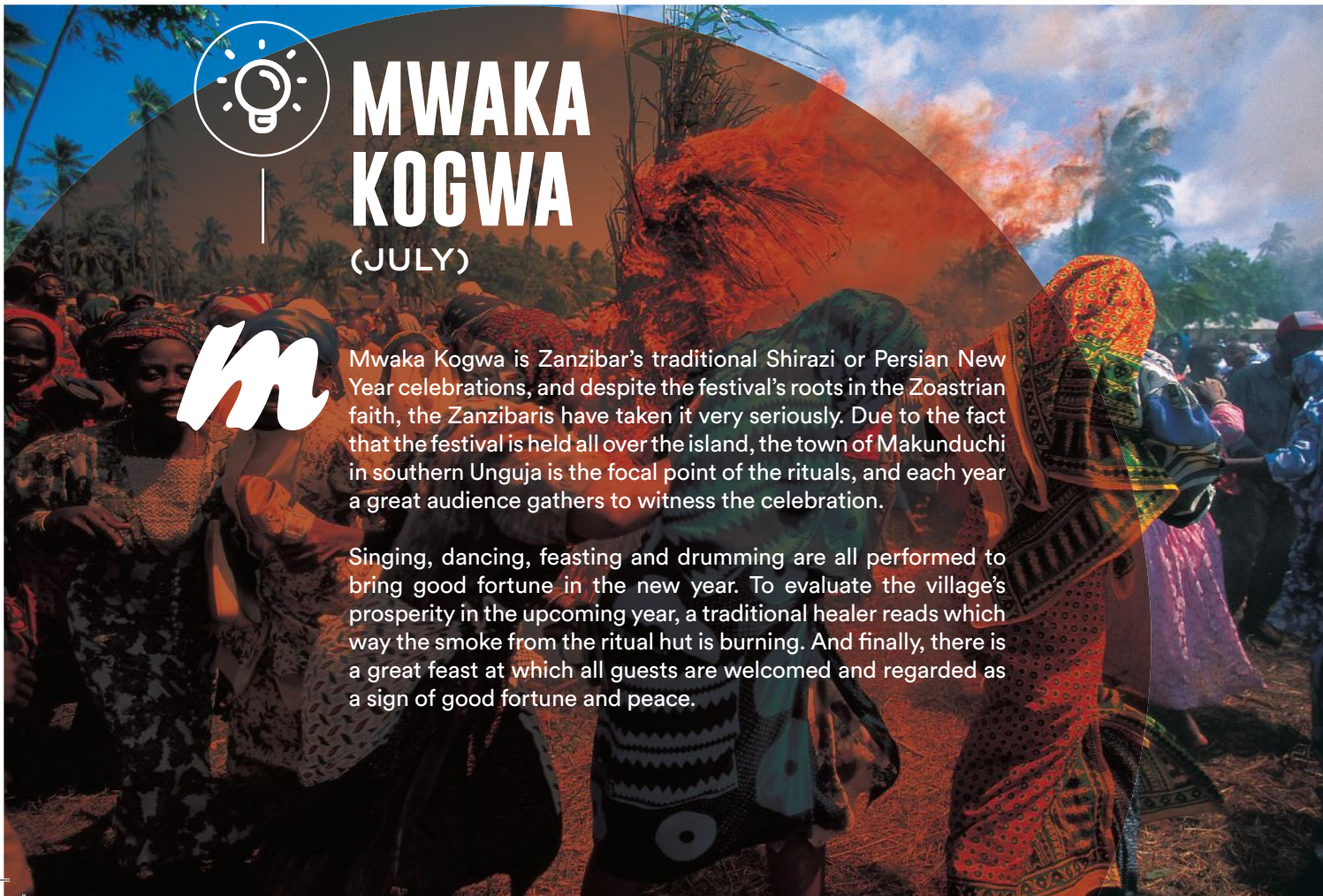


MWAKA KOGWA (JULY)

Due to the fact that the festival is held all over the island, the town of Makunduchi in southern Unguja is the focal point of the rituals, and each year a great audience gathers to witness the celebration.

Singing, dancing, feasting and drumming are all performed to bring good fortune in the new year. To evaluate the village's prosperity in the upcoming year, a traditional healer reads which way the smoke from the ritual hut is burning. And finally, there is a great feast at which all guests are welcomed and regarded as a sign of good fortune and peace.

ZANZIBAR STONETOWN



*t*he Old Stone Town is a World Heritage declared by UNESCO in more than a decade now. In order to protect the town, the government has established Stone Town Conservation and Development Authority (STCDA). Discover and tour the main City market, which opened in 1904, to obtain a full picture of Stone Town's architecture, including its sand and stone antique built buildings with Arab/Indian carved doors with brass studs and carved balconies.

Along the twisting lanes of Stone Town, former palaces and Arab mansions (Sultan's Palace Museum, House of Wonders also known as Beit-el-ajab built in 1886) hint at a grander age for this port city on Zanzibar's western coast. The old fort, which was built to fend off the Portuguese in the 1700s, today serves as a venue for local performances, a café, and an art gallery. The Anglican Cathedral of Christ, of course, is a must-see which was built by bishop steers in 1873 on the site of the old slave market.



SPICE PLANTATIONS



Zanzibar was one of the world's main spice growers, and the spices and herbs were brought to Zanzibar by Portuguese traders from their possessions in South America and India in the 16th century.

One of the most popular excursions in Zanzibar, the Spice Island, is the Spice Tour. It is a half-day excursion that begins with a drive through the countryside's lush vegetation, followed by walks through several spice plantations such as cloves, cardamom, cinnamon, black pepper, turmeric, vanilla, nutmeg etc. During the tour, you will be able to smell and taste spices, herbs as well as tropical fruits and at the end of the tour you will enjoy a typical Swahili lunch at the farm at the end of the tour, where you will be able to experience the many ways of utilizing spices, and the tour will conclude with a stop to a spice stall selling fresh packed spices.

JOZANI FOREST NATIONAL PARK

Jozani Forest is a terrestrial and intertidal protected area dedicated to biodiversity protection that receives funding from access fees, filming levy, research activity, grants, and other sources.

The forest is 35 kilometers south of Zanzibar town, and it takes around 45 minutes to get there from the city center. It is a wetland and forested region of around 1000 hectares. The beauty of the Jozani forest trip is that the height of the trees and palms is just breathtaking, ensuring that visitors have a wonderful experience. You can see the famous and rare Red Colobus Monkeys, Bushbaby, 50 different species of butterflies, 40 species of birds, and a variety of plants and trees while walking through mangrove swamp boardwalks. 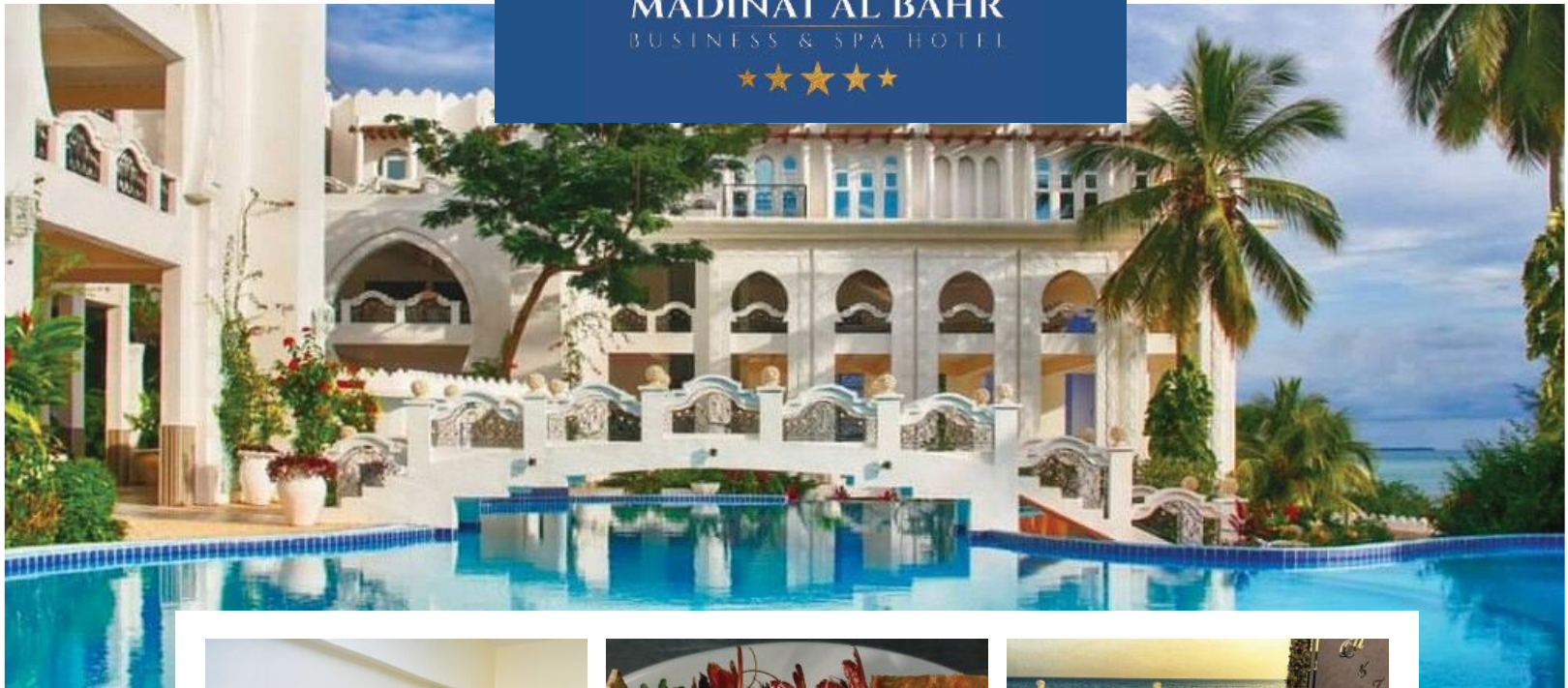

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About 20 minutes by boat from forodhani area lies Prison Island also known as Changuu or quarantine island. In the 1893, the former British prime minister of Zanzibar purchased the island and built a prison complex on it. But – it never served to its intended use! It was used as a quarantine station for yellow fever cases. The island, on the other hand, was formerly utilized by the Arab traders to house the more feisty and troublesome slaves transported from African mainland.

Furthermore, the collapsing cells of the old prison may still be seen today, and they serve as a temporary home for giant tortoises and peacocks brought from the Seychelles by the Sultan in the 1820s. Sunbathing, swimming, snorkeling, and resting on the white sand beach are all popular activities on the island. Upon your return admire the breathtaking view of the Stone Town, the harbor and the archipelago.

There are 15 private cottages situated around the beachfront, each with amazing panoramic views of the ocean and tastefully painted in light hues to complement the laid-back atmosphere. At low tide, the beach is beautiful, with unusual stone formations.

PEMBA FLYING FOX



t The Pemba flying fox has a fascinating foxlike face that is hidden beneath a bright auburn coat. These bats are among the world's largest fruit bats. Their wings can extend over 5.5 feet across, although weighing only 400–650 grams. They live in enormous social colonies that can number up to 850 individuals. Fruit such as figs, breadfruits, and mangos, as well as nectar, pollen, flowers and leaves make up the majority of their diet.

They are a vital spice for dissemination since their digestive system transports fruit and plant seeds to other regions of the island. The conservation of these bats gives local residents a sense of accomplishment and development, as they actively participate in environmental preservation. The economic benefits derived from this little community tourist project have already shown to be quite beneficial.



NGEZI FOREST RESERVE

The reserve is located on the northwestern tip of Pemba Island and covers 14.4 square kilometers (5.6 square miles). It is the only place in Eastern Africa with such a diverse range of flora kinds.

In sandy-loam soils and Mtifutifu soils, the forest comprises of coral shrubs and thickets, thick grasses and plants. The forest line with closed vegetation stretches up to the beach at Vumawimbi, providing a fantastic tropical experience for visitors to the new tourist facilities.

Misali, as a Marine Conservation Area, is known for its diverse marine and terrestrial ecosystems, which include 350 different fish species and 40 different hard coral genera. The endangered nesting turtles may be found in the 1 km square of terrestrial area, and the dense coastal thickets are home to green monkeys, the endangered and endemic Pemba flying fox, internationally endangered coconut crabs, and a variety of bird species.

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Taxes on Tourist Activity Services

The Zanzibar Revenue Board (ZRB) is the prime Agency of the Revolutionary Government of Zanzibar (RGoZ) for Collection and Administration of all Taxes from inland Revenue sources other than customs duties, excise duties for locally produced goods and income taxes that are administered by Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA) Office in Zanzibar. Revenue collections returned to Citizens for the purpose of providing better social services and strengthening various development in Zanzibar Islands. ZRB has strong ties to the Tourism business, which is, in recent years has been one of the mainstays of the Zanzibar economy and has made significant contributions to tax collections leading to boost in GDP.

The Tour Operator Services sector is one among important source of revenue for ZRB collection. These services include tourist attractions in various parts of Zanzibar such as beaches and seas, historical sites as well as forest areas. In addition, ZRB collects taxes on tourist activities including Excursion, Diving Games, Kites, as well as other tourist sports. Tax Administration and Procedures Act (TAPA) requires every Tour Operators to register with ZRB not less than fifteenth day from the date of commencement of business activities. Tour Operators obligate to pay 12% from the sales of such services and submitted to ZRB within 20 days the business month in addition to tax obligation.

Zanzibar Revenue Board (ZRB) continues to remind and encourage travel service providers that, the obligation for issuing electronic receipts known as **VFMS** is a key factor in fulfilling their duty to collect Government revenue.

In promoting the Tourism Sector through the Blue Economy, the Eighth Phase Government has created a business-friendly environment and tax collection. Its our hope, every Trader through Tourism industry, ensure to follow the rules and regulations set, for the interest of Zanzibar.

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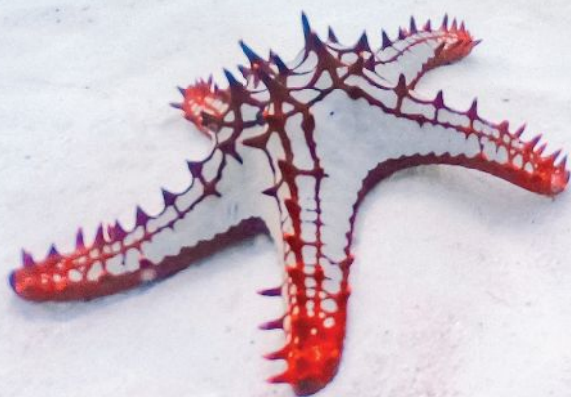
